The Applicants request that You respond to the following Interrogatories and Data Requests by **May 3, 2004**, the date set by the Siting Council for completion of discovery concerning Electric and Magnetic Fields.

Definitions and Instructions

A) As used in these requests, "You" means each of: Ezra Academy, Congregation B'nai Jacob, The Jewish Community Center of Greater New Haven, and The Jewish Federation of Greater New Haven.

B) The "Property" means each of the following: (1) The land, buildings, structures,

and facilities on and near Rimmon Road in Woodbridge, Connecticut now occupied by Ezra Academy and Congregation B'nai Jacob; and (2) the land, buildings, structures, and facilities on and near Amity Road in Woodbridge now occupied by The Jewish Community Center of Greater New Haven and The Jewish Federation of Greater New Haven.

C) In responding to these requests, please identify each individual who will verify the information when it is received into evidence.

D) Please note that the following requests do **not** seek the production of any documents created by the Applicants that have been filed, or provided to You, in the course of this proceeding.

Interrogatories and Data Requests

a. Have You conducted or caused to be conducted, at any time, anywhere on the Property any investigations, measurements, or characterization of electric fields, magnetic fields, ground currents, contact currents, or the potential for contact currents?

b. If You have responded affirmatively to Question 1, describe each such activity, including the nature of the investigation, measurement, or characterization, the dates on which it was conducted, the person or firm who conducted the activity, its purpose, and its results.

c. Provide copies of all records of the activity, specifically including any memoranda or other documents recording any field or current measurements.


d. If you are in possession of any records of investigations, measurements, or characterization of fields or currents on the Property conducted by others, provide copies of such documents.

e. If any measurements were taken inside buildings, please provide a floor plan of each such building, labeled so as to permit identification of the room, and if possible of the location within the room, in which each measurement was taken.

f. If any measurements were taken outside buildings, please provide a plot plan labeled so as to permit identification of the location where each measurement was taken.
