Dear Chairman Stein:

The United Illuminating Company (“UI”) received acknowledgement from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) on April 8, 2014 that the UI proposed upgrade of the Elmwest Substation would not have a substantial adverse environmental effect, and pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 16-50k, would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need with the condition that UI file a Development & Management Plan. The United Illuminating Company regrets that it failed to provide a completion date in a timely fashion and hereby notifies the Connecticut Siting Council that site construction at the substation has concluded in accordance with the D&M Plan filed on April 28, 2014.

UI submits this letter to provide notice that UI has accomplished the following:

- UI completed construction on March 9, 2015; this letter provides notice of completion of construction.
- There were no material changes or other deviations from the Council's approvals. Enclosed are this original and two (2) copies of this Notice of Completion.
