

Pursuant to Section 16-50j-62 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies and the Connecticut Siting Council's September 3, 2015 approval of SolarCity Corporation's Petition for Declaratory Ruling, SolarCity Inc. hereby submits its Monthly Progress Report for October 2015.

The status of the Facility's construction for October 2015 was as follows:

- Site clearing activities have been completed in Phase 1 and Phase 2 areas.
- Erosion control berm and silt fence were installed in accordance with wetland protection plan.
- Environmental Monitoring is being provided by All Points Technologies with preconstruction education and periodic inspections.
- Phase 1 area civil work complete, seeded and mulched.
- Phase 1 solar installation started.
- Phase 2 commenced stumping and road construction.
- No changes to D&M plan were required for October 2015.
