Re: Petition of The United Illuminating Company for a Declaratory Ruling that No Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is Required Regarding Modifications to the 115-Kv Transmission Lines in Milford Connecticut

Dear Chairman Stein:

Please find enclosed an original and twenty copies of The United Illuminating's Petition to the Connecticut Siting Council requesting a determination that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is necessary for proposed work on the Connecticut Department of Transportation's ("CDOT") right-of-way ("ROW") in Milford.

UI undertook an aging infrastructure study in an effort to maintain a reliable electric power system in southwestern Connecticut. This study identified two 'H' frame transmission structures outside of the Company's Milvon Substation located at 772 Bridgeport Avenue in Milford that currently do not meet the 2012 National Electric Safety Code ("NESC"). The work proposed in UI's Petition seeks to remedy these deficiencies, and includes the installation of 6 tubular steel monopole structures within the ROW.

PETITION FOR DECLARATORY RULING

This petition is filed pursuant to Section 16-50k of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-50j-39 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.


The United Illuminating Company ("UI" or the "Company"), an electric public service company specially chartered by the General Assembly of the State of Connecticut and having its principal place of business in Orange, Connecticut, hereby petitions the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need ("Certificate") is required pursuant to Section 16-50k of the Connecticut General Statutes for the project hereinafter described. UI submits that such certification is not required because the project, although it encompasses "modifications" of a "facility", will not have substantial adverse environmental effect.

As part of the continuing effort to maintain a reliable electric power system in southwestern Connecticut,





Figure 2: Aerial photograph of Milvon Substation & 'H' frame structures

See Figures 1 and 2. In addition, as part of Petition 1110 UI is increasing the conductor size on

these structures located within the Connecticut Department of Transportation ("CDOT") right-of way ("ROW").

As a result, UI plans to install 6 tubular steel monopoles outside of the substation to the northwest and remove the existing structures. The project will be performed entirely within the Connecticut Department of Transportation's ("CDOT") existing right-of-way. *See* Figures 1 and 2.

PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS

UI proposes to install six tubular steel structures to the northwest of the substation and connect them to the 115kV electric transmission lines that enter the substation from the east and west as seen in Figure 3. These will be dead-end type structures that will on average be 90 feet tall.



All of the work will be performed and located entirely within the Connecticut

Department of Transportation's ("CDOT") existing right-of-way ("ROW"). Construction

impacts on the proposed project to the environment are expected to be minimal and will consist

of the temporary placement of swamp mats over the wetland in order to gain access and erect the

structures. The wetland located just to the north of Milvon Substation is fed by the Beaver

Brook corridor. Placement of the new structures will not be within these wetlands.

Any excess soils during site preparation will be stockpiled on site and disposed of based on a pre-characterization study previously performed. Dewatering activities, if required, will be managed in accordance with the State of Connecticut's General Permit, Groundwater

Remediation Wastewater to a Sanitary Sewer. The project is anticipated to commence in September 2015 with projected completion by December 2016.

Normal work hours for construction will be between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Work will proceed Monday through Friday, excluding some holidays. The proposed work hours may include evening and weekend hours on a temporary and case-by-case basis in order to complete critical installation.

EXISTING FACILITY




Figure 5: Existing Facility

Milvon Substation is an 115kV to 13.8 kV distribution substation. The existing 'H' frame structures were built in 1953. These structures support two 115-kV transmission line circuits that also feed other UI substations in the vicinity. The structures consist of a combination of steel 'I' beams bolted together and supporting guy wires. The transmission lines dead-end at the top of these structures and have conductor taps that drop down to a horizontal member. These conductors cross over the Metro-North Railroad and then tap into Milvon Substation as seen in Figure 5. The Site is surrounded by commercial and public areas. To the north of the site is the Beaver Brook Trails. To the southeast and southwest of the site are automobile service and sale businesses. *See* Figure 6.

DISCUSSION

Based on the results of the study and increasing the conductor size under Petition 1110, it was determined that six tubular steel structures are required to be installed outside of Milvon Substation.

While the above-referenced work constitutes a "modification" of an existing facility, there will be no substantial adverse environmental impact associated with the proposed project:

- All work will be done entirely within the CDOT ROW, making use of existing property. No additional property or right-of-way will need to be purchased or secured.
- The project will cause no significant effects on surrounding land use and aesthetics, terrestrial ecology, traffic or water quality.
- The project will not significantly impact the views from surrounding areas. The
 removal of the low-lying shrubbery on the southerly side of the substation will have
 no impact.
- There will be no change in operating noise levels at this facility as a result of the proposed modification.
- During construction, sediment and erosion controls will be installed based on UI's Stormwater Pollution Control Plan submitted and approved on February 3, 2015 by the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection. Any excess soils left after construction will be managed based on the pre-characterization of that material and where necessary disposed of in accordance with the necessary State guidelines and requirements.

Based on the above, UI respectfully submits that the proposed project will not have a

substantial adverse environmental impact and does not warrant submission of a full Certificate

Application to the Council. Accordingly, UI requests that the Council declare that the proposed

project described herein will not have a substantial adverse environmental effect and, therefore,

that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required.
