
The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated March 24, 2017, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on June 11, 2015.

Pursuant to Condition No. 2 of the Council's Decision on June 11, 2015, your request to perform work from 9:00 am until 6:00 pm on Sunday, March 26, 2017; Sunday, April 2, 2017; Sunday, April 9, 2017; and Sunday, April 16, 2017 at Haddam Substation is hereby approved. The Sunday work hours are necessary in order to meet the scheduled outages in coordination with Millstone Power Plant.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated March 24, 2017. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.


