**RE: PETITION NO. 1178 – DESRI CT Fusion Acquisition, LLC declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed construction, operation and maintenance of a ground-mounted 20 megawatt solar photovoltaic electric generating facility located on Potash Hill Road, Sprague, Connecticut. D&M Plan Revision.**

Dear Attorney Baldwin:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated March 6, 2017 including the revised Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the above-referenced project. In response to your March 6, 2017 request, pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62(b), Council staff hereby acknowledges receipt and approves the revised D&M Plan, which includes, but is not limited to, the revised Stormwater Pollution Control Plan dated January 9, 2017 and updated Construction Plans, Structural Design Package and Electrical Design received on March 6, 2017. The revision of the D&M Plan is necessary due to an ownership change of the Fusion Solar Center at 111 Potash Hill Road. These changes include, but are not limited to, the location and footprint of the array layout, location of temporary and permanent stormwater controls, a revised limit of disturbance, and relocation of perimeter erosion and sedimentation controls.

This approval applies only to the D&M Plan revision received on March 6, 2017. Any significant changes to the D&M Plan require advance Council notification and approval.
