RE: **PETITION NO. 1180** - Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed installation of a small cell telecommunications facility on the roof of an existing building at Holy Family Monastery Retreat House & Center located at 303 Middle Road, Farmington, Connecticut.

Dear Attorney Baldwin:

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §§ 4-176 and 16-50k, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) issues declaratory rulings for modifications to existing facilities and facilities required to be approved by declaratory ruling per statute. The Council routinely imposes standard conditions when issuing declaratory rulings. The Council's declaratory rulings state, "...if the facility authorized herein is not fully constructed within three years...this decision shall be void." Furthermore, the Council may add site-specific conditions that require project developers to provide written confirmation to the Council that the conditions have been met.

To date, the Council is not in receipt of any communication that site-specific conditions applied to the above referenced declaratory ruling have been met. The Council is also not in receipt of any notification that construction has been completed.

The Council hereby requests compliance on these matters no later than January 31, 2019. If additional time is needed to gather the requested information, please notify the Council in writing prior to that date.
