Pursuant to the Connecticut Siting Council's ("Council") November 13, 2015 Development and Management ("D&M") Plan Decision Letter and Section 16-50j-62(b) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, on November 19, 2015, SolarCity Corporation ("SolarCity") requested Council staff approval to remove a single line of trees. Based on further review, SolarCity has determined that these trees can be trimmed in a manner in which they would survive and would not interfere with SolarCity's construction or operation of the solar photovoltaic electric generating facility. Therefore, SolarCity respectfully requests staff approval of the trimming of the trees as shown in revised Sketch SK-1 attached to this letter. Finally, based on the change from tree removal to tree trimming, SolarCity believes that the Council's November 20, 2015 interrogatories are moot.
