The United Illuminating Company ("UI") received acknowledgement from the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on January 7, 2016 that the UI proposed construction, operation and maintenance of a 2.8 Megawatt AC Fuel Cell to be located at Amity Regional High School, 25 Newton Road, Woodbridge, Connecticut would not have a substantial adverse environmental effect, and pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 16-50k, would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need. UI regrets that it failed to provide the completion date in a timely manner in accordance with the Council's conditions, and hereby submits this letter to provide notice that construction was completed, and the fuel cell was commissioned, on December 16, 2016.
