RE: **PETITION NO. 1240** - Wallingford Energy, LLC, on behalf of the Town of Wallingford Electric Division, declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed modifications to the town's existing Wallingford 13M substation located at 195 East Street in Wallingford and modifications to several existing town-owned 115-kV electric transmission lines including the reconductoring and extension of the 1305 line, the circuit-separation of the 1630 and 1640 lines and the potential re-routing of the 1208 line located in Wallingford, Connecticut.

Dear Attorneys Sussman and Boye-Williams:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the correspondence dated November 22, 2016 regarding the minor project changes to the Petition for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on August 4, 2016. The Council is also in receipt of the structural drawing for structure number 1640-2 that was submitted in compliance with the October 25, 2016 approval of previous changes to the transmission route, structure design and final laydown area.

Pursuant to Condition No. 3 of the Council's Decision on August 4, 2016, your request for the minor relocation of structure 1640-2 slightly to the west is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the minor project changes dated November 22, 2016. Any significant changes to the Petition require advance Council notification and approval.
