Enclosed please find the final first phase of the Development and Management (“D&M”) Plan for the approved Project referenced above. In this filing we have enclosed fifteen (15) reduced sets of project plans and one (1) full size set of the plan.

This submission represents the first of three (3) Project phases we intend to submit to the Siting Council. This initial phase of the Project includes clearing the site in anticipation of future construction activities (to be represented in subsequent D&M Plan submissions, phases 2 and 3). We anticipate that our phase 2 D&M Plan would be submitted in advance of your December 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting and cover work planned for the time period between the 22<sup>nd</sup> and January 6, 2017. The 3<sup>rd</sup> and final D&M Plan would then be filed prior to your January 6<sup>th</sup> meeting. We hope that this proposed schedule of submittals in three (3) stages is acceptable and will assist the Siting Council in its review and approval process.

At this time, we respectfully request that the enclosed information (Phase 1 D&M Plan) be reviewed and this matter placed on the December 8<sup>th</sup> Siting Council agenda for approval. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions or require additional information.
