Pursuant to Section 16-50j-22a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, the Council hereby grants the request for an extension of time to January 20, 2017.

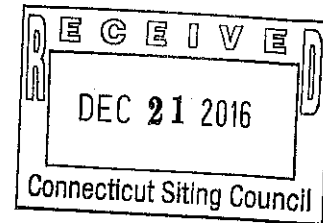

**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO
RESPOND TO COUNCIL INTERROGATORIES**

Doosan Fuel Cell America, Inc. ("Doosan") hereby moves the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") for an extension of time to respond to the Council's Interrogatories issued December 5, 2016, in the above-captioned matter. In support of this Motion, Doosan states:

1. Doosan received the Interrogatories via electronic mail on December 4, 2016, and via regular mail thereafter. The deadline to respond to the Interrogatories is December 23, 2016. Doosan also received Interrogatories in petitions from the Council during this time period with deadlines for response during the same week.
2. The Interrogatories contain requests for a noise analysis and the Council has requested more specific studies be provided to support our specifications, along with other requests for other additional detailed information from Doosan. Doosan has already engaged outside firms regarding conducting a noise analysis, but the procurement process and the analysis require additional time.
3. While Doosan has begun to make progress on answering some of the Interrogatories, Doosan requires additional time in order to conduct a full sound analysis for each site, and to more fully

assess and gather the information and data needed to adequately and fully answer all
Interrogatory questions on each petition.

WHEREFORE, for all of the foregoing reasons, Doosan hereby requests that the Council
grant an extension of time to respond to the Interrogatories until January 20, 2017.
