
**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO
RESPOND TO COUNCIL INTERROGATORIES**

Doosan Fuel Cell America, Inc. ("Doosan") hereby moves the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") for an extension of time to respond to the Council's Interrogatories Set Three, issued December 28, 2016, in the above-captioned matter. In support of this Motion, Doosan states:

1. Doosan received the Interrogatories via electronic mail on December 27, 2016, and via regular mail thereafter. The deadline to respond to the Interrogatories was extended to February 17, 2017, per Doosan's Motion for Extension filed January 26, 2017.
2. The Interrogatories contain a request for a detailed site drawing and site specific noise analysis. Doosan is also required to provide detailed site drawings and noise analysis for two other petitions by the February 17th deadline.
3. While Doosan has provided answers to all other Interrogatories in Set Three, due to staffing needs and unforeseen issues in obtaining the detailed site plans and sound study analysis, Doosan now requires additional time to complete the site drawings and sound studies to ensure they are in accordance with requisite standards.

WHEREFORE, for all of the foregoing reasons, Doosan hereby requests that the Council grant an extension of time to respond to Interrogatory No. 41 and No. 44 until February 24, 2017.
