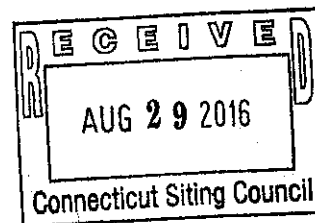

Re: Petition 1217- Bloomfield-Windsor Upgrades Project
Development and Management Plan - Transmission Line

Dear Chairman Stein:

On behalf of The Connecticut Light and Power Company dba Eversource Energy ("Eversource") and pursuant to Condition 1 of the Connecticut Siting Council's May 3, 2016 Ruling on the Petition 1217- Bloomfield-Windsor Upgrades Project, enclosed are an original and 15 copies of Eversource's Development and Management Plan for the upgrade of approximately 6.9 miles of existing 115-kV lines within the Town of Bloomfield, Connecticut ("D&M Plan"). An electronic version on CD-ROM of the D&M Plans is also enclosed.

The D&M Plan is comprised primarily of text and a set of drawings for the construction and upgrades of approximately 6.9 miles of existing 115-kV lines between Bloomfield Substation and North Bloomfield Substation in Bloomfield.

The D&M Plan for the transmission line construction consists of the following volumes:

- Volume I: 115-kV Transmission Line Upgrades
- Volume II: Approvals, Permits, and Best Management Practices for Transmission Line and Substation Construction Activities
- Volume III - Transmission Line Drawings


As Volume II is common to both the Substation and Transmission Line D&M Plans, only one copy has been provided with the filing of the Substation D&M Plan (Filed Substation D&M Plan - Volume II on July 29, 2016 to the CSC).

Eversource recently met with Town officials to discuss the D&M Plans and solicit comments. The D&M Plan reflects Eversource's efforts to address the comments received from the municipalities.

In accordance with Condition 1 of the Council's Decision and Order, Eversource is furnishing a copy of the D&M Plan to municipal officials of the towns of Bloomfield and Windsor.

Eversource requests that the Council review and approve the D&M Plan.
