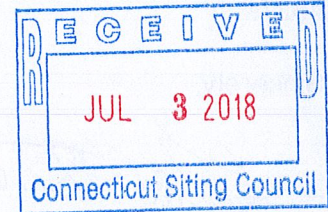

Dear Chairman Stein:

The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy ("Eversource") hereby provides its Final Report for the Bloomfield-Windsor Upgrades Project (Project) to the Connecticut Siting Council (Council). This Final Report is submitted in accordance with the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RSCA), Section 16-50j-62(c); the Council's Decision and Order regarding the Project; and the Council's approval of the Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the Project.

Pursuant RSCA Section 16-50j-62(c), the Final Report identifies the following:


1. All agreements with abutters or other property owners regarding special maintenance precautions;
2. Significant changes to the D&M plan that were required because of the property rights of underlying and adjoining owners or for other reasons;
3. The location of construction materials which have been left in place including, but not limited to, culverts, erosion control structures along watercourses and steep slopes, and corduroy roads in regulated wetlands;
4. The locations of areas where special planting and reseeding have been performed; and
5. The actual construction cost of the facility, including, but not limited to, the following costs:
  - a. Clearing and access;
  - b. Construction of the facility and associated equipment;
  - c. Rehabilitation; and
  - d. Property acquisition for the site or access to the site.



As explained in the December 2017 Monthly Construction Progress Report, the project construction work was deemed complete as of that date. Eversource is hereby providing the Final Report on the Project (See Attachment).

## ATTACHMENT

### Eversource Petition No.1217: Bloomfield-Windsor Upgrades Project – Final Report

1. Eversource did not enter into any agreements with abutters or other property owners regarding special maintenance precautions.
2. There was one significant change to the D&M plans made during construction of the project, which was submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council on January 6, 2017. This change requested the shift of the access road between Wintonbury Avenue and structures 3-107, 3-108 and 3-109. As originally proposed the access roads introduced safety concerns, due to the required minimum clearance under the conductor for the contractor's construction equipment. In addition to the shift of the access road, Eversource proposed to shift the crossing for the temporary stream span (PS-3 Unnamed Tributary to Beamans Brook) between 3-108 and 3-109. The new location is slightly north of the existing location. This change was approved and implemented in accordance with the amended D&M Plan -Sheet 4.

Notice and/or information was provided to the Council and/or Council staff on matters considered to be minor changes to the D&M Plan. The information included, but was not limited to, changes to work hours, work days, identification of construction contractors and minor changes to the D&M Plan.
