Staff Report

On July 21, 2016, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) issued a Declaratory Ruling to PSEG Power Connecticut LLC (PSEG) that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 485 megawatt (MW) dual fuel combined-cycle electric generating facility at the existing Bridgeport Harbor facility site at 1 Atlantic Street, Bridgeport, Connecticut. As required in the Council's Decision and Order, PSEG submitted Phase I of its Development and Management Plan (D&M Plan) for this project on September 21, 2016. Phase I of the D&M Plan is currently under review. By letter dated September 21, 2016, PSEG submitted a request to the Council for approval of certain site staging and preparation activities in advance of the Council's review and approval of Phase I of the D&M Plan.

Specifically, PSEG seeks to install a project trailer in the Bridgeport Harbor Unit 6 trailer facility area to support site geotechnical and preliminary engineering team activities. The size of the trailer is projected to be up to a "five-wide" modular trailer. PSEG also seeks to remove the existing trees on the containment berms, as well as trees along the site's eastern shoreline in the vicinity of Bridgeport Harbor Unit 1. Additionally, PSEG proposes to perform fencing repairs, security booth and communications installation, grading/stoning restoration, as well as parking bumper, and laydown dunnage installation in PSEG-owned on-site and near-offsite laydown and parking areas of Bridgeport Harbor Units 2 through 4. PSEG owns all of these properties and currently uses them for similar parking and storage purposes. Lastly, PSEG seeks to install communications cabling (underground) from utility "hubs" in or near the existing Bridgeport Harbor Unit 3 Training Trailer, to the existing Atlantic Street Guard Shack.
