The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your request dated October 25, 2017 regarding the temporary change to work hours approved approved as part of the Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on September 6, 2017.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62(b), your request to work on Sunday, October 29, 2017 and Sunday, November 5, 2017 during daylight hours to perform chritical path testing on the site is hereby approved. 
