Dear Ms. Bachman:

I am writing on behalf of my client, Woods Hill Solar, LLC, in connection with the above-referenced Petition. This letter is a follow-up to prior correspondence to the Council regarding the completion of critical path work at the site. Woods Hill Solar, LLC is writing this letter to request permission to perform critical path mechanical installation and electrical testing works on the site. This work would consist of a team of approximately 75 individuals performing work on the site as follows:

- 25 individuals who would be responsible for attaching racking structures atop alreadydriven piles, which would be secured by nuts and bolts using small hand tools;
- 25 individuals who would be responsible for attaching individual modules to the racking structure, which would be secured by nuts and bolts using small hand tools;
- 15 people for electrical commissioning and testing work; and
- 10 individuals responsible for management and safety.

Woods Hill Solar, LLC is requesting to perform this work from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, December 3, 2017 and Sunday, December 10, 2017. The work is anticipated to be quiet in nature and would not include pile driving, drilling, deliveries of materials, or civil work.

Prior to making this request, representatives of Woods Hill Solar, LLC contacted the nearest neighbor to the site, Kathleen Cutler, to obtain her consent to this work. Ms. Cutler consented to Woods Hill Solar, LLC performing this work, provided that no pile driving, drilling, deliveries of materials, or civil work would take place.
