RE: **PETITION NO. 1230** – Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed modifications to its existing Stony Hill Substation including the installation of a new access road to the substation on Eversource's property located at 49 Stony Hill Road, Brookfield, Connecticut.

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your email correspondence dated February 22, 2017 regarding the minor project changes to the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was approved by the Council on June 23, 2016.

Pursuant to Condition No. 4 of the Council's June 23, 2016 Decision, your request for the installation of a temporary 56.5-foot tall wood pole to support transmission line guy wires is approved. The temporary pole is necessary to provide clearance for the safe operation of construction vehicles.

This approval applies only to the minor project changes submitted on February 22, 2017. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.



On behalf of The Connecticut Light and Power Company dba Eversource Energy ("Eversource") and pursuant to approved Petition No. 1230, Eversource is informing the Connecticut Siting Council staff on the the addition of a temporary "stub" pole on Eversource property at the Stony Hill Substation to facilitate the safe construction of the approved modifications. The existing guy wires attached to Structure 4647A , located east of the substation's existing eastern fence line needs to be shifted to a new temporary wood stub pole to allow greater room for the safe passage of construction vehicles and equipment to the work area. The temporary stub pole would be 56.5 feet high and would be located approximately 56 feet east from the existing 70 foot high structure. See attachment.
