RE: **PETITION NO. 1230** – Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed modifications to its existing Stony Hill Substation including the installation of a new access road to the substation on Eversource's property located at 49 Stony Hill Road, Brookfield, Connecticut.

Dear Ms. Taylor:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence of January 12, 2018 regarding a temporary change to construction work hours for the above-referenced Project that was approved by the Council on June 23, 2016.

Pursuant to Condition No. 4 of the Council's Decision of June 23, 2016, your request to perform 24-hour work from January 16 to January 19, 2018 and work on Sunday, January 21, 2018 is hereby approved. This modified work hour request is necessary to vacuum fill and circulate transformer oil on a continuous basis and to perform transformer testing during a scheduled outage. Work hours on Sunday, January 21, 2018 will be from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

This approval applies only to the request for a temporary change to Project work hours dated January 12, 2018. Any significant changes to the Project require advance Council notification and approval.

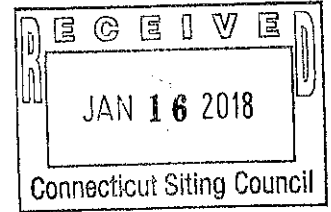

Eversource Energy is requesting approval of work hours from Connecticut Siting Council staff for 24 hour work from January 16 to January 19 and for work on Sunday, January 21 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. The Tuesday-Friday continuous work schedule is needed to vacuum fill and circulate oil in the new transformer, which must run continuously. In addition, Sunday work hours are required for testing the transformer after filling during a scheduled outage. The crew will perform low noise activities during this time.

The Town of Brookfield and the abutters have be notified of the proposed work schedule.
