RE: **PETITION NO. 1230** – Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed modifications to its existing Stony Hill Substation including the installation of a new access road to the substation on Eversource's property located at 49 Stony Hill Road, Brookfield, Connecticut.

Dear Ms. Taylor:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence of June 25, 2018 regarding a temporary change to construction work hours for the above-referenced Project that was approved by the Council on June 23, 2016.

Pursuant to Condition No. 4 of the Council's Decision of June 23, 2016, your request to perform work from 7 PM to 9 PM from June 26 through June 29, 2018 is hereby approved. This modified work hour request is necessary to perform quiet synchronous condenser testing within the condenser enclosure during a scheduled outage event.

This approval applies only to the request for a temporary change to Project work hours dated June 25, 2018. Any significant changes to the Project require advance Council notification and approval.

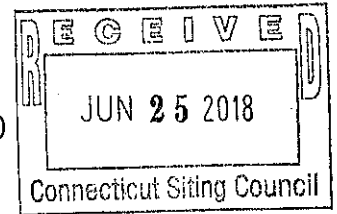
