Sorry for the delay, I am on storm duty. It was a typo.

Below is my new request.

Dear Ms. Bachman:

Eversource is requesting Connecticut Siting Council staff approval of the following modifications to Petition 1238:

- As a result of further coordination with the Army Corps of Engineers within the levee permitting area, Eversource is requesting the installation of an additional pull pad (30 feet x 100 feet) between structures 3022 and 3023 to facilitate the conductor installation. The pull pad would be located adjacent to the existing temporary matting within the wetland. There would be no permanent impacts to the wetland. See Attachment: Mapsheet 6.
- Eversource is requesting a new access to structure 3052 from Main Street in South Windsor for splicing the OPGW. The existing mats between structures 3046 and 3052 have been removed due to flooding concerns. The new proposed access is an existing dirt and gravel road. A construction mat (16 feet x 90 feet) would be installed to protect a small wetland. There would be no permanent impacts to the wetland and vehicle use to this area will be a limited to pickup truck or a splicing van. The property owner has agreed to Eversource's use of the proposed access. See Attachment: Mapsheets 10 and 11.

The municipal officials of East Hartford and South Windsor have been notified about these proposed modifications.

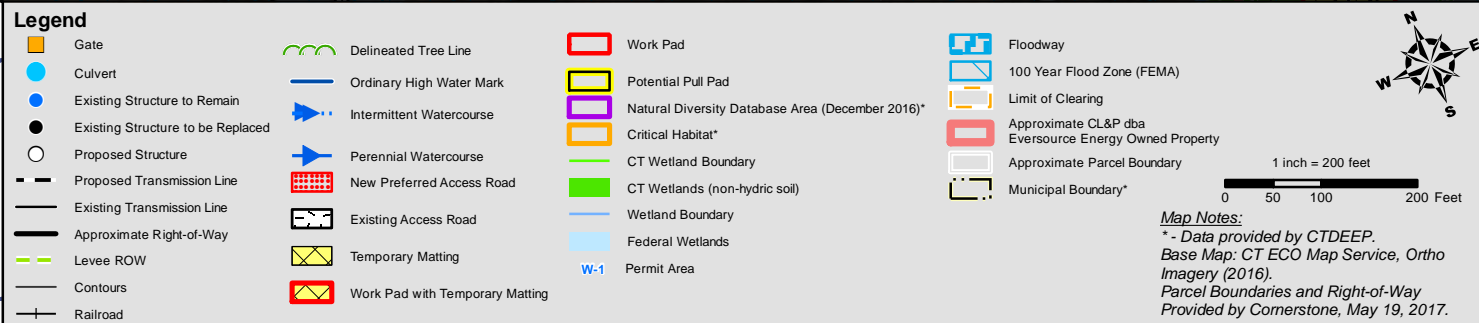
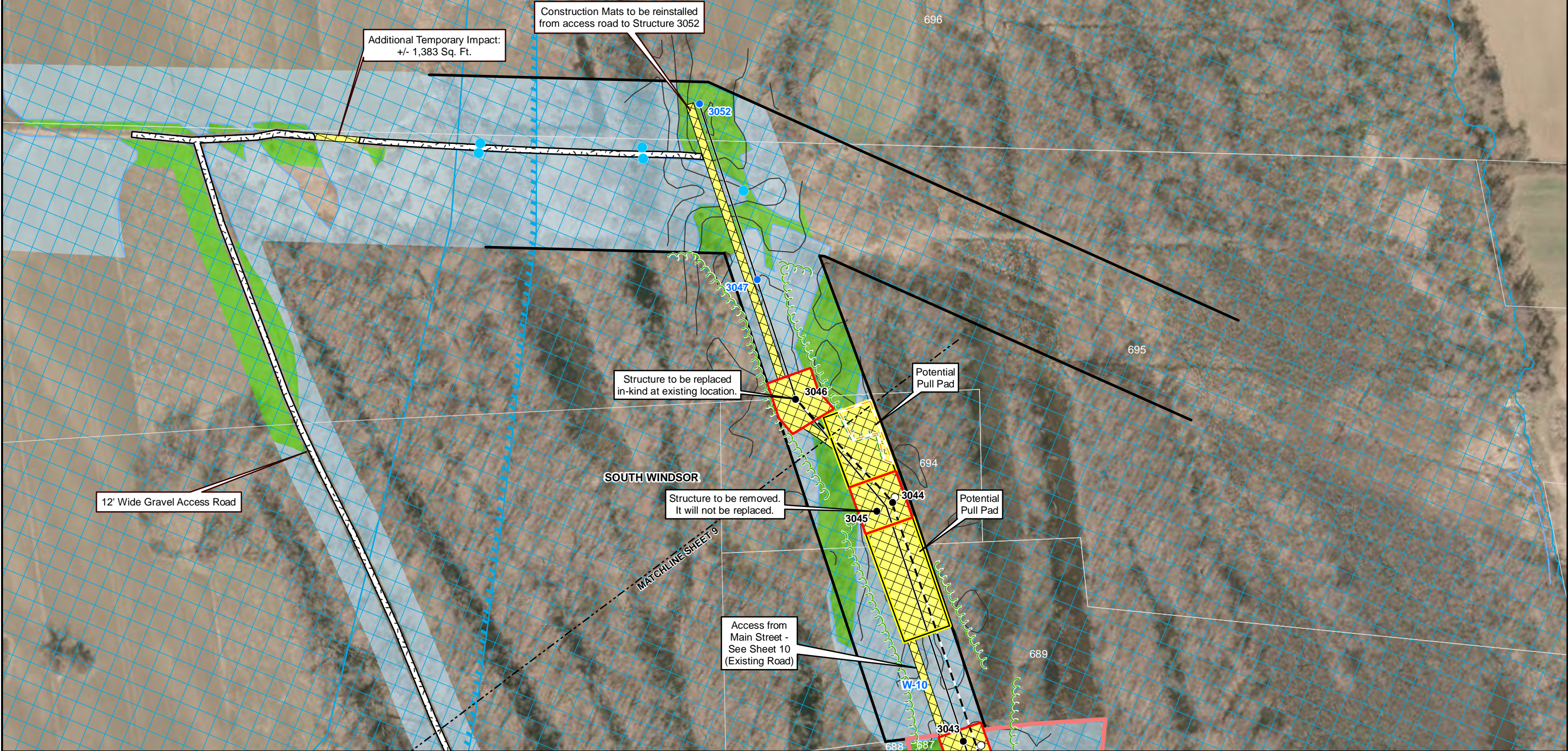
