RE: **PETITION NO. 1238** - Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed re-conductoring of 0.6 miles of its existing No. 1779 115-kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line between South Meadow Substation in Hartford and the east side of structure 3001 in East Hartford and for the proposed rebuilding of 4.6 miles of its existing No. 1779 electric transmission line within existing Eversource right of way extending from structure 3001.5 in East Hartford to South Windsor Junction in South Windsor, traversing the municipalities of Hartford, East Hartford, and South Windsor, Connecticut, and related transmission line structure and substation improvements.

Dear Ms. Taylor:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your email correspondence of March 22, 2018 regarding a temporary change to work hours for the above-referenced Project that was approved by the Council on October 27, 2016.

Pursuant to Condition No. 3 of the Council's Decision on October 27, 2016, staff hereby approves the requested change in work hours to allow project work on Sundays from March 25 to April 29, 2018. All Sunday work would be performed from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and would include foundation installation and new conductor pulling in East Hartford and South Windsor during the scheduled outage. The change in work hours is necessary to recover work time lost due to recent winter storm events.

This approval applies only to the request for a temporary change to project work hours in your email of March 22, 2018. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.
