RE: **PETITION NO. 1238** - Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed re-conductoring of 0.6 miles of its existing No. 1779 115-kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line between South Meadow Substation in Hartford and the east side of structure 3001 in East Hartford and for the proposed rebuilding of 4.6 miles of its existing No. 1779 electric transmission line within existing Eversource right of way extending from structure 3001.5 in East Hartford to South Windsor Junction in South Windsor, traversing the municipalities of Hartford, East Hartford, and South Windsor, Connecticut, and related transmission line structure and substation improvements.

Dear Ms. Taylor:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence of January 12, 2018 regarding the temporary change to work hours for the above-referenced Project that was approved by the Council on October 27, 2016.

Pursuant to Condition No. 3 of the Council's Decision on October 27, 2016, your request to perform construction activities on Sundays from January 21 to March 18, 2018 along the Connecticut River flood control levee in East Hartford is hereby approved. Work hours on these Sundays will be from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. This modified work hour request is necessary due to a delay in obtaining a permit from the U.S. Army Corp of Engineers, now received, for work in the levee area.

This approval applies only to the request for a temporary change to Project work hours dated January 12, 2018. Any significant changes to the Petition require advance Council notification and approval.



Eversource recently received the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers 408 permit for construction within the Connecticut River flood control levee. Due to the construction delay in the levee area, Eversource is requesting approval of Sunday work hours (8 a.m. to 5 p.m.) starting January 21 to March 18 from Council staff for installation of access roads, foundation, structure erection and installation of the new conductor from structures 3001 to 3021 during the scheduled outage.
