RE: PETITION NO. 1240 - Wallingford Energy, LLC, on behalf of the Town of Wallingford Electric Division, declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed modifications to the town's existing Wallingford 13M substation located at 195 East Street in Wallingford and modifications to several existing town-owned 115-kV electric transmission lines including the reconductoring and extension of the 1305 line, the circuit-separation of the 1630 and 1640 lines and the potential re-routing of the 1208 line located in Wallingford, Connecticut.

Dear Attorneys Sussman and Boye-Williams:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated October 20, 2016 regarding the minor project changes to the Petition for the above-referenced site that was approved by the Council on August 4, 2016.

Pursuant to Condition No. 3 of the Council's Decision on August 4, 2016, your request for the transmission route modification, structure design updates, and final laydown area are hereby approved with the condition that an updated structural drawing for structure number 1640-2 be submitted to the Council within 30 days of this approval.

This approval applies only to the minor project changes dated October 20, 2016. Any significant changes to the Petition require advance Council notification and approval.
