The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated March 16, 2017 regarding the minor project changes to the above-referenced declaratory ruling that was approved by the Council on August 4, 2016.

Pursuant to Condition No. 3 of the Council's Decision on August 4, 2016, your request to relocate a 90-foot communications pole approximately 131 feet from its location outside of the eastern existing fence line of substation to outside the southern fence line is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the minor project changes dated March 16, 2017. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

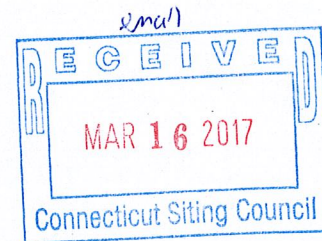

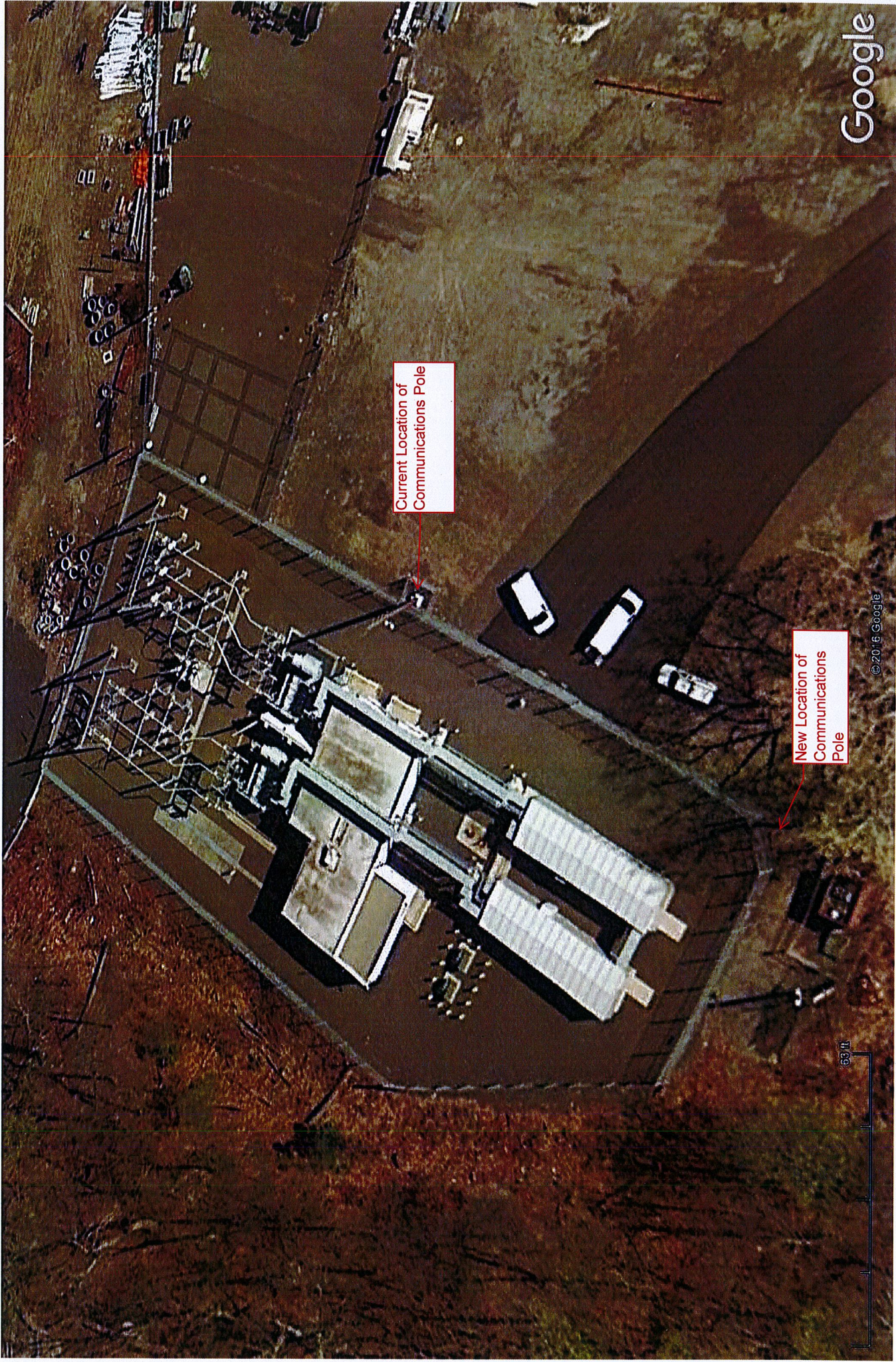
