
Dear Attorney Mondschein:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your request dated May 8, 2017 to revise the Phase II and Phase III Development and Management Plans (Phase II and III D&M Plans) for the above-referenced project. In response to your May 8, 2017 request, pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62(b), Council staff hereby acknowledges receipt and approves the revisions to the Phase II and Phase III D&M Plans which consist of reducing the fence height from eight feet to six feet.

This approval applies only to the Phase II and Phase III D&M Plans revision received on May 9, 2017. Any significant changes to the D&M Plan require advance Council notification and approval.

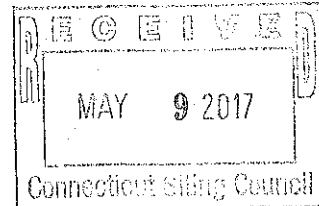
