PETITION NO. 1248 - TRS Fuel Cell, LLC petition for a Declaratory Re: Ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is Required for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 3.7 megawatt combined heat and power fuel cell facility located at 64 Triangle Street, Danbury, Connecticut.

Dear Ms. Bachman:

In accordance with condition number 4 of the decision in the abovereferenced Petition, TRS Fuel Cell, LLC ("TRS"), owner of the above-captioned project (the "Project"), submits its (i) final site plan and (ii) security fence detail.

As directed by the Council, TRS collaborated with the City of Danbury (the "City") to arrive at the proposed security fence design. At the City's request, TRS will erect an Alumi-Gard or similar brand security grade fence around the fuel cell facility as depicted in the attached security fence detail sheet. This heavygrade, decorative fence will allow the fuel cell to be viewed from safely outside the secured area. This fencing is similar to that installed at the Bridgeport Fuel Cell Park.

From the Alumi-Gard fence ends, to the corner of Triangle Street and Starr Street, TRS will erect an eight (8)-foot high chain link fence. At a point approximately half way between the existing driveway entrance to the corner of Starr Street, a new approximately 24-foot wide entranceway will be constructed which will feature a sliding security gate. In order to protect the stability of the proposed fencing and security of the site it is necessary to remove the remaining berm and overgrown brush proximate to Triangle Street.

Please note that the attached security fence detail sheet was shared with, and approved by, the City of Danbury via email.
