
Dear Chairman Stein:

On November 10, 2016, Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) received a declaratory ruling from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) that a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need would not be required for the work proposed in Petition No. 1252, subject to conditions. Among other conditions of the ruling, the Council required that Eversource submit the following item:

- The Council shall be notified in writing within 45 day of when the existing wood pole telecommunications facility is removed and the new self-supporting lattice tower is operational. The existing wood was removed and the new self-supporting lattice tower was operational on February 28, 2017.
