Pursuant to Condition No. 3 of the Council's Petition No. 1254 decision of November 10, 2016 on this project, the proposed fence modification from a vinyl stockade fence to a chain link fence with privacy slats to surround the ground-mounted equipment at the request of the property owner is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the minor project changes dated April 26, 2017. Any minor changes to the facility require advance notification and approval.



At a public meeting held on November 10, 2016, the Siting Council (“Council”) approved the above-referenced Petition for Declaratory Ruling allowing for the installation of a small cell wireless facility at 327 Huntington Street in New London, Connecticut. The approved facility is currently under construction.

Recently, the property owner has asked Verizon Wireless to change the type of fence that would surround its ground-mounted equipment cabinets, and install a chain link fence with privacy slats in lieu of the vinyl stockade fence originally proposed in the Petition. Verizon Wireless is willing to accommodate the owner’s request and now seeks staff approval of this minor modification.


