Pursuant to Section 16-50j-22a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, the Council hereby grants the request for an extension of time to February 17, 2017.

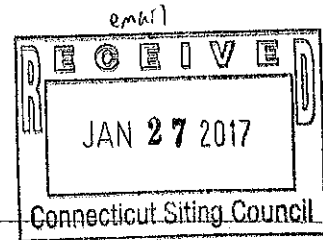


**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO  
RESPOND TO COUNCIL INTERROGATORIES**

Doosan Fuel Cell America, Inc. ("Doosan") hereby moves the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") for an extension of time to respond to the Council's Interrogatories Set Three, issued December 28, 2016, in the above-captioned matter. In support of this Motion, Doosan states:

1. Doosan received the Interrogatories via electronic mail on December 27, 2016, and via regular mail thereafter. The deadline to respond to the Interrogatories was extended to January 30, 2017, per Doosan's Motion for Extension filed January 9, 2017.
2. The Interrogatories contain requests for a site specific noise analysis and the Council has requested more specific studies be provided to support our specifications, as well as a detailed site plan. Doosan has already engaged outside firms regarding conducting a noise analysis and site plan; however, due to cloudy and rainy weather, the outside firm was not able to timely conduct the noise study and complete the required analysis.
3. While Doosan has prepared answers to the remaining Interrogatories, Doosan requires additional time in order to conduct a full sound analysis for the site and to have the detailed site plan completed per Interrogatories No. 32 and No. 33. Doosan will submit all other Interrogatory responses by the current deadline of January 30, 2017.

WHEREFORE, for all of the foregoing reasons, Doosan hereby requests that the Council  
grant an extension of time to respond to the Interrogatories No. <sup>41</sup>~~32~~ and No. <sup>44</sup>~~33~~ until  
February 17, 2017.
