The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated March 23, 2017, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on February 16, 2017.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Decision on February 16, 2017 and page 3 of the Council staff report, your request to perform work from 9:00 am until 6:00 pm on Sunday, March 26, 2017 and Sunday, April 2, 2017 at Southington Substation is hereby approved. The Sunday work hours are necessary due to postponed work caused by high winds during the week of March 20, 2017, and the need to meet a scheduled outage.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated March 23, 2017. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

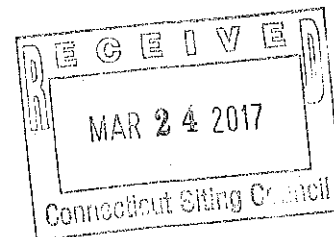
