RE: PETITION NO. 1283 – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed modifications to the existing Southington Substation located at 315 Bellevue Avenue, Southington, Connecticut.

Dear Attorney Lord:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated July 24, 2018, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on February 16, 2017.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Decision on February 16, 2017, your request to perform work until 9:00 p.m. on Saturday, July 28, 2018 and from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 29, 2018 and, as a contingency, during the same extended hours on Saturday, August 4, 2018 and Sunday, August 5, 2018 at Southington Substation is hereby approved. The extended work hours are necessary due to an unexpected change in scheduled outages from the Connecticut Valley Electric Exchange (CONVEX). Eversource will perform work within the control house and security fence of the substation.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated July 24, 2018. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.



Dear Ms. Bachman:

Eversource Energy is requesting approval from Connecticut Siting Council staff for extended work hours at Southington Substation on Saturday, July 28th until 9 p.m. and on Sunday, July 29th from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. The extended work hours are required due to an unexpected change in scheduled outages from CONVEX resulting in an accelerated schedule. The work will be performed within the control house and security fence of the substation. Eversource is also requesting the same extended hours for Saturday, August 4th and Sunday, August 5th as a contingency, in the event that additional time is needed to complete the work scheduled for this weekend. However, CONVEX has not yet finalized the studies needed to schedule that outage. We will keep you apprised our progress and the status of the August outage.

The Town of Southington has been notified of the proposed work schedule.
