The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated February 1, 2019, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on February 21, 2017.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Decision on February 21, 2017, your request to perform work from 7:00 p.m. to midnight on February 1 and 2 and from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on February 3, 2019 within the control enclosure at Southington Substation is hereby approved. The extended work hours are required due to a schedule change in switching and related outage due to the cold temperatures.

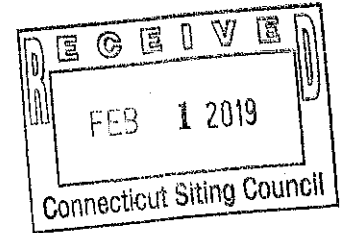
