Dear Ms. Taylor:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated September 6, 2018, regarding Sunday work hours for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on February 16, 2017.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Decision on February 16, 2017, your request to perform work from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the following Sundays, September 9, October 7 and 14, November 25, and December 2, 2018 at Southington Substation is hereby approved. The extended work hours are necessary due to a change in scheduled outages to complete the installation of the line reactors. Eversource will perform work within the security fence of the substation.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated September 6, 2018. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.


