The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your email correspondence dated March 21, 2018, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on March 30, 2017.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Decision of March 30, 2017, your request to perform work from 8 AM to 6 PM on the following Sundays -March 25, April 8, and April 15 - at the Green Hill Substation is hereby approved. The work is necessary to complete testing of substation equipment during scheduled outages. The majority of testing will consist of quiet work within the substation control house using a minimal work crew.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated March 21, 2018. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

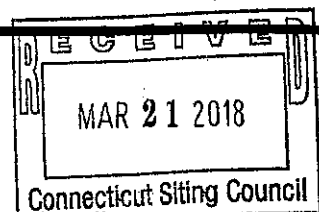
