RE: **PETITION NO. 1291** - Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the Towantic Line Upgrades Project that includes rebuilding and reconductoring approximately 4.4 miles of its existing 115-kilovolt electric transmission lines within existing Eversource right of way between Devon 7R Substation and East Devon Junction both located in the City of Milford, Connecticut; between the West Devon Junction located in the Town of Stratford, Connecticut and Trumbull Junction located in the Town of Trumbull, Connecticut; and between Devon 7R Substation located in the City of Milford, Connecticut and West Devon Junction located in the Town of Stratford, Connecticut and related transmission line structure improvements.

Dear Ms. Shanley:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated May 17, 2018, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on April 27, 2017.

Pursuant to Condition No. 4 of the Council's Decision on April 27, 2017 and page 4 of the Council's staff report, your request to perform extended work hours from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 20, 2018 is hereby approved. Work will be performed in Stratford in the vicinity of Structure Nos. 825, 829 and 830 and in Trumbull in the vicinity of Structure Nos. 832 and 833. Such work includes, but is not limited to, installing the temporary wood guard structure along the Route 15 exit ramp and preparing for wire pulling operations. The extended work hours are necessary to complete work during a scheduled outage and to make up for lost time due to storm restoration work.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours in the email correspondence of May 17, 2018. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

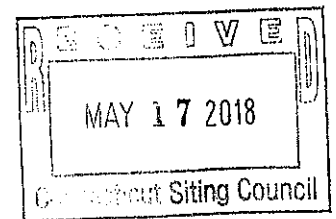
