RE: **PETITION NO. 1291** - Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the Towantic Line Upgrades Project that includes rebuilding and reconductoring approximately 4.4 miles of its existing 115-kilovolt electric transmission lines within existing Eversource right of way between Devon 7R Substation and East Devon Junction both located in the City of Milford, Connecticut; between the West Devon Junction located in the Town of Stratford, Connecticut and Trumbull Junction located in the Town of Trumbull, Connecticut; and between Devon 7R Substation located in the City of Milford, Connecticut and West Devon Junction located in the Town of Stratford, Connecticut and related transmission line structure improvements.

Dear Ms. Shanley:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated March 1, 2018, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on April 27, 2017.

Pursuant to Condition No. 4 of the Council's Decision on April 27, 2017 and page 4 of the Council's staff report, your request to perform extended work hours for Thursday, March 1, 2018 from 7:00 p.m. to midnight is hereby approved. Work will be performed in the vicinity of Structure Nos. 833 and 833A along the driveway into Trumbull Substation. The extended work hours are necessary due to the impending storm and the inability to obtain an outage for tomorrow; thus, Eversource will need to complete its work during the current outage.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours in the email correspondence of March 1, 2018. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

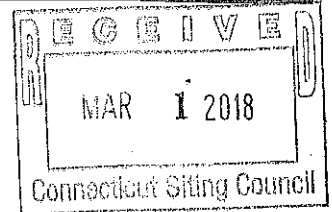

Hi Melanie:

Eversource is requesting extended work hours today, March 1, 2018 from 7PM until midnight under the subject petition. The work activity will be in the vicinity of Structures 833 and 833A along the driveway into United Illuminating's Trumbull Substation off of Route 108/Nichols Avenue in the Town of Trumbull. The work activity consists of setting the top of the temporary steel guyed structure, wire work between the temporary steel structure and the existing lattice structure #833A and wire work on Structure #833. This work required coordination with United Illuminating and since they had switching delays due to emergency work they had this morning, Eversource's work was not able to start until 1PM this afternoon. Eversource's work requires an one-day outage and due to the impending storm, Eversource cannot get an extension to today's outage for tomorrow and this work needs to be completed during the current outage. Eversource has already provided notice to the Town of Trumbull and will be providing notice this afternoon to the residential neighbors along Wildflower Lane, Huntington Turnpike, Nichols Ave and Stella Street of this pending work.
