RE: **PETITION NO. 1291** - Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the Towantic Line Upgrades Project that includes rebuilding and reconductoring approximately 4.4 miles of its existing 115-kilovolt electric transmission lines within existing Eversource right of way between Devon 7R Substation and East Devon Junction both located in the City of Milford, Connecticut; between the West Devon Junction located in the Town of Stratford, Connecticut and Trumbull Junction located in the Town of Trumbull, Connecticut; and between Devon 7R Substation located in the City of Milford, Connecticut and West Devon Junction located in the Town of Stratford, Connecticut and related transmission line structure improvements.

Dear Ms. Bellion:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated September 6, 2018, regarding Sunday work hours for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on April 27, 2017.

Pursuant to Condition No. 4 of the Council's Decision on April 27, 2017, your request to perform extended work hours from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 9, 2018 is hereby approved. The work is related to the completion of wire pulling activities from Structure No. 814A in Stratford to Structure No. 833A in Trumbull that is necessary to complete during a scheduled outage.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated September 6, 2018. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.

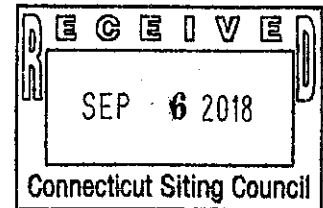
