

The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource) received approval from the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on November 26, 2018 (Petition No. 1293). In its November 26, 2018 letter acknowledging the above-referenced Sub-Petition, the Council included conditions regarding the work undertaken pursuant to this Sub-Petition. Eversource is requesting an extension of the deadline for completing the work activities based on the following condition:


- The petitioner may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one year deadline provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.
