Structure Locations: 117 Transmission Structures located in Lebanon, Bozrah, Montville and Waterford, Connecticut

I. Introduction:

In accordance with Condition 1 of the March 30, 2017 ruling by the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") (as set forth in the Council's March 31, 2017 letter) regarding Petition No. 1293, The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy ("Eversource") submits this Sub-Petition.

II. Description of Transmission Work Activities:

Eversource's 310/371/383 Transmission Line Structure Replacement Project in Connecticut is part of an ongoing maintenance program which evaluates the integrity of its utility structures and implements repair, upgrade or replacement in order to ensure the safe and reliable transmission of power to its customers. Due to asset condition, many structures require replacement on portions of the 310, 371 and 383 Lines. All three lines are 345-kV single circuit lines. The 310 Line extends from Manchester Substation in Manchester to Millstone Substation in Waterford. The 371 Line extends from Montville Substation in Montville to Millstone Substation. The 383 Line extends from Card Substation in Lebanon to Millstone Substation. The 310/383 share the same ROW between Card Substation and Millstone Substation and all three lines share the same ROW between Hunts Brook Junction in Montville and Millstone Substation. Each of the three lines has some structures that require replacement. Of these replacements, 117 structures require a slight increase in structure height to comply with current clearance requirements. The 117 structures to be replaced are a mix of wood H-frame and monopole structures.

Eversource plans to conduct transmission structure replacement work to remediate structure damage caused by structure age, weather, and woodpecker activity. The following work ("Work Activities") will be performed:

- Replace 117 existing wood structures with new weathering steel structures. Each replacement structure will be the same design as its corresponding existing structure, though slightly taller (10 feet or less) than the existing structures. The replacement structures will be installed within 15 feet of the existing structure locations.

III. No Substantial Adverse Environmental Effect:

Eversource respectfully submits that the proposed modifications would have no "substantial adverse environmental effect" pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-50k, based on the following factors:

- a) Work Activities would take place in areas within Eversource's property and existing rights-of-way ("ROWs") utilizing existing and proposed new permanent access roads, as well as some temporary access roads (collectively the "Work Areas"). Some of the existing access roads will be improved. Eversource can access the structure replacement locations utilizing its existing rights, but it is currently working with private landowners to obtain rights to utilize alternative off-ROW access routes that would minimize the amount of proposed temporary access roads that would need to be installed within the ROW and lessen the impacts to wetlands and/or agricultural areas.
- b) Work Activities would currently result in approximately 317,977 square feet ("SF") of temporary wetland impacts, limited to temporary construction matting required for the construction of access roads and work pads for 47 structures. See Table 1 for a summary of these temporary wetland impacts.

Work would be conducted in accordance with Eversource's *Best Management Practices Manual for Massachusetts and Connecticut (Construction and Maintenance Environmental Requirements)*, September 2016 ("BMPs") to avoid impact to nearby wetland and watercourse resources.

- c) No direct impacts to vernal pools ("VPs") would result from the proposed Work Activities. Vernal pool species protection measures will be implemented where Work Activities extend into vernal pool envelopes ("VPE"). A total of 15 VP habitats have been identified near Work Activities. Each VP has been assigned a successive number from north to south, respectively (VP1 through VP15). There are no proposed Work Activities within the VPEs of VP6, VP10, VP11 and VP12. Existing access roads will not be widened or altered where they extend into the VPEs of isolated VP habitats, including: VP1, VP3, VP4, VP8, and VP15. Elevated construction matting will be installed as needed within VPEs where access roads bisect wetland habitats that may provide migratory routes for amphibian movement, including: VP2, VP7, VP9, VP13, and VP14. Existing access roads in these areas will not be altered or widened. A portion of the work pad for structure 5682 is located within VPE3 and a portion of the work pad for structure 9907 is located within VPE5. Non-elevated construction matting will be utilized on the temporary work pads for structures 5682 and 9907 to avert amphibian access and avoid entrapment.

An Environmental Monitor will be employed to monitor the Work Areas for activities conducted during the amphibian breeding season. If amphibian migration activity starts during Work Activities, additional BMPs will be implemented to protect vernal pool species. With the implementation of these protective measures, no adverse impact to vernal pools would result from the proposed Work Activities.

- d) As a result of Eversource's review of the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's ("CTDEEP") Natural Diversity Data Base ("NDDB"), only the Work Activities associated with the access roads and work pads for structures 21046, 21047, 21088, 29033, 21168, 21170, 29013, 29012, 5637,5741, 5635, 5739, 5633, 5632, 5727, 5622, and 5620 are proposed within a NDDB buffered area and wetland jurisdictional area and/or CTDEEP owned/managed land and therefore would be subject to a NDDB review request. Eversource is currently in consultation with CTDEEP regarding Eversource's proposed work in these areas and will adhere to any state-listed species protection measures recommended by CTDEEP, as

necessary. Any recommended measures will be incorporated into Eversource's BMPs during construction. With these protection measures, no adverse impacts to state-listed rare species are anticipated.

- e) The Work Activities will not require any tree clearing. However, Eversource may need to undertake minor tree trimming and/or vegetation removal/mowing within the managed ROW corridor to improve access to portions of the Work Areas.
- f) A Phase 1A assessment review of previously recorded cultural resources on file with the Connecticut State Historic Preservation Office conducted by Heritage Consultants, LLC ("Heritage") did not identify any National or State Register of Historic Places properties/districts located within 500 feet of the Work Areas. However, one historic standing structure is situated within 500 feet of the Work Areas identified at 97 Spithead Road in Waterford. This property contains a Greek Revival residential structure that was recorded back in the 1990's during a town wide inventory through a SHPO grant program to perform a windshield survey under the direction of the local historical society to identify historical structures. Based on existing conditions, the like-for-like design of the replacement structures, and the modest average height increase of 5 feet per structure, none of the proposed Work Activities would directly impact this historic structure or substantially change views of the ROW from the historic structure.

Based on a review of historic maps, aerial photographs, and available soil profiles, 45 of the proposed work pad locations and related access roads were identified to possess a potential for moderate to high archaeological sensitivity. These locations were evaluated in the field by Heritage with either a pedestrian survey or a Phase 1B cultural resources reconnaissance survey (shovel pit testing). None of the structure locations and/or associated Work Areas yielded potential for or evidence of archaeological deposits. Therefore, no further cultural investigation is recommended or warranted, and no protective measures are required. As a result of the completed investigations the proposed Work Activities will not have an adverse effect on any cultural resources.

- g) Increases in the heights of the 117 replacement structures will average approximately 5 feet and none will exceed 10 feet.
- h) Replacement structures would be located within 15 feet of existing structures.
- i) Work areas associated with structures 21087 and 21088 are located either partially or wholly within mapped floodway and 100-year flood zones associated with the Yantic River. Work areas associated with structure 21156 are located partially within a mapped 100-year flood zone associated with Oxoboxo Brook. Eversource would utilize its BMPs to minimize any impacts to the flood zones by utilizing temporary construction matting or by not placing fill that would increase the elevations of the existing or proposed road surfaces or work pads to ensure that the floodway and floodplain hydrology would not be adversely affected. With these protective measures and the use of BMPs, no adverse impact to the floodway or 100-year flood zones would result from the proposed Work Activities.
- j) No change in noise levels would result from the installation of the new structures and the applicable lines would continue to comply with the State of Connecticut noise regulations.
- k) Any changes in electric and magnetic field levels outside the ROW would be negligible.

#### IV. Mitigation:

Temporary environmental effects from construction will be mitigated as follows:

- Erosion and sediment controls ("E&S") will be employed and maintained, as needed, throughout the execution of the Work Activities in accordance with the 2002 Connecticut Guidelines for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control and the BMPs.
- Potential impacts to wetlands and watercourses will be mitigated with the use of temporary construction matting and adherence to the BMPs.
- Vernal pool protective measures will be incorporated into the Eversource's BMPs during construction.
- NDDDB recommended rare species protective measures will be incorporated into Eversource's BMPs during construction.
- Potential impacts to the floodway and 100-year flood zones would be avoided with adherence to the BMPs and the use of temporary construction matting.
- Eversource's contractor will perform construction sequencing such that any earth materials are exposed for a minimum of time before they are covered, seeded, or otherwise stabilized to prevent erosion.
- During construction, when necessary, anti-tracking mats would be installed at construction entrances onto public roads to prevent tracking of soil onto local streets.
- Upon completion of the Work Activities, all disturbed/exposed areas would be stabilized and revegetated. After the establishment of permanent ground cover, Eversource's contractor would remove the temporary E&S controls and remove/dispose of any accumulated sediments and debris from areas where such measures were used.

#### V. Access:

Some new permanent access roads would be constructed to facilitate access to structures within the ROW and existing access roads in upland areas may be hardened and temporarily widened at turning areas to facilitate the safe passage of construction vehicles. Construction matting would be used on temporary access roads in wetlands as well as in agricultural/maintained lawn upland areas. The matting will be removed upon completion of the Work Activities and the areas restored, as necessary.

Eversource would access the Work Areas by entering its Property and/or ROW from existing access points on public roads as follows:

##### Lebanon

- Krause Road for structures 21002 and 21006, (off-ROW access from Village Hill Road for structure 21006 would be used if rights are obtained)
- Burham Road for structure 21015
- Schaulk Road for structures 29160, 21025, 21026, 21027, 29154 and 21029
- Trumbull Highway for structures 21030, 21031 and 21034
- Mack Road for structures 21035 and 21036
- Barker Road for structure 21040
- Exeter Road for structures 21046, 21047, 21050 and 21051

- Goshen Hill Road for structures 21052, 21053, 21054, 21055, 21056, 21057, 21058, 21059, 21060 and 21063 (off-ROW access from Browning Road for structures 21058, 21059 and 21060 and from Waterman Road for structure 21063 would be used if rights are obtained)
- Waterman Road for structures 21067, 21068 and 29115
- Santa Anna Road for structures 29114, 21071, 29108, 21076 and 29106 (off-ROW access from an alternative location on Santa Anna Road for structure 29114 would be used if rights are obtained)

Bozrah

- Stanton Road for structures 21080, 21081, 21085, 29098, 29097, 21087 and 21088
- Bashon Hill Road for structure 29086
- South Road for structure 21129






