RE: SUB-PETITION NO. 1293 - MGP-02 (Manchester-Glastonbury-Portland) — Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for all transmission facility asset condition maintenance improvements statewide to comply with the updated National Electrical Safety Code clearance requirements.

Dear Ms. Shanley:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated March 21, 2019 regarding a minor project change to the Petition No. 1293 sub-petition for the above-referenced section of transmission line that was approved by the Council on January 22, 2019.

The proposed minor project change consists of the replacement of three additional structures on the #3424 Line due to poor asset condition, as follows: Structure 12189 in Glastonbury, and Structures 12149 and 12134 in Portland. These three wood H-frame structures will be replaced with weathering steel structures of the same design, will be installed within 15 feet of the existing structures, and raised in height by no more than 10 feet to comply with current conductor clearance requirements. Access to the structures will be along existing roads within Eversource's right-of-way. The work areas were assessed for environmental and archeological resources in accordance with Petition 1293 sub-petition procedures. Work procedures incorporating environmental mitigation measures at Structure 12149 will be followed in accordance with Eversource's Best Management Practices for the previously approved Project.

Pursuant to the Council's Petition No. 1293 decision of March 31, 2017 and the January 22, 2019 decision on this sub-petition, your request for the proposed modifications is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the minor project changes dated March 21, 2019. Any additional minor changes to the sub-petition decision require advance notification and approval.

Amendment to Sub-Petition

Dear Ms. Bachman:

On January 22, 2019, the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") issued a ruling that the subject project would not have an adverse environmental effect and would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need.

Since the time of the Council's ruling, Eversource has identified three additional transmission structures on the 3424 Line that require replacement due to asset condition, Structures 12189, 12149 and 12134. Eversource plans to conduct the transmission structure replacement work ("Work Activities") to remediate structure damage caused by age, weather, and woodpecker activity. The three H-frame structures will be replaced with light duty weathering steel structures of the same design. The replacement structures will be installed within 15 feet of the existing structures and be raised in height less than 10-feet to comply with current conductor clearance requirements. Work Activities would take place in areas within Eversource's property and existing right-of-way ("ROW") utilizing existing access roads (collectively the "Work Areas"). See revised Attachment C; "3424 Line Structure Replacement Project" "Sub-Petition Map Set", dated December 19, 2018, revised March 11, 2019.

Eversource respectfully submits that the proposed modifications would have no "substantial adverse environmental effect" pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-50k, based on the following factors;

Work Activities associated with the three additional replacement structures will not result in any impacts to wetlands and there are no flood zones, vernal pools, or vernal pool envelopes located in the Work Areas. Temporary environmental effects from construction will be mitigated using appropriate erosion and sediment controls ("E&S") in accordance with the 2002 Connecticut Guidelines for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control and Eversource's Best Management Practices Manual for Massachusetts and Connecticut (Construction and Maintenance Environmental Requirements), dated September 2016 ("BMPs"). Upon completion of the Work Activities, all disturbed/exposed areas would be stabilized and revegetated. After the establishment of permanent ground cover, Eversource's contractor would remove temporary E&S controls and remove/dispose of any accumulated sediments and debris from areas where such measures were used.

As a result of Eversource's review of the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection's ("CTDEEP") Natural Diversity Database ("NDDB"), only Structure 12149 is proposed within an NDDB area and wetland jurisdictional area and/or CTDEEP owned/managed land and therefore would be subject to an NDDB review request. Eversource submitted an NDDB review request to CTDEEP on December 14, 2018 regarding structure replacement work for the project and received a response from CTDEEP on January 25, 2019 with recommendations for the protection of rare species potentially present. The recommended protection measures identified in the NDDB letter have been accepted by Eversource and will be incorporated into the Projects BMPs, project plans and construction activities. With these protective measures, no adverse impacts to state-listed rare species are anticipated.

A Phase 1A assessment conducted by Heritage Consultants, LLC ("Heritage") did not identify any National or State Register of Historic Places properties/districts located within 500 feet of the Work Areas. Based on a review of historic maps, aerial photographs, and available soil profiles, two proposed work pad locations associated with Structures 12149 and 12189 were identified as having the potential for moderate to high archaeological sensitivity. These locations were evaluated in the field with a pedestrian survey by a representative from Heritage and confirmed to have a potential for moderate to high archaeological sensitivity. A Phase 1B cultural reconnaissance survey (shovel pit testing) was conducted and resulted in the identification of a single historic cultural locus at Structure 12149. This locus was further evaluated by Heritage and determined to be insignificant and unassociated with any intact structural remains. No other physical evidence of archaeological significance was found at either Structure. Therefore, the Work Activities associated with the two work pad locations will not impact any significant cultural resources. Heritage has determined that no further investigation is recommended or warranted, and no protective measures are required.

The Work Activities will not require any tree clearing. However, Eversource may need to undertake minor tree trimming and/or vegetation removal/mowing within the managed ROW corridor to improve access to the Work Areas.

No change in noise levels would result from installation of the new structures and the line would continue to comply with the State of Connecticut noise regulations. Any changes in electric and magnetic field levels off the ROW would be negligible.

Prior to submitting this amendment Eversource representatives briefed officials in the towns of Glastonbury and Portland concerning the project modifications. In addition, Eversource provided abutters with written notice of the filing of the Amendment.

Eversource will access Work Areas using existing access roads within the right-of-way ("ROW") from existing access points on public roads as follows:

- Neipsic Road in Glastonbury for Structure 12189
- East Cotton Hill Road in Portland for Structure 12149
- Old Marlborough Turnpike in Portland for Structure 12134





Manchester, Glastonbury, & Portland, CT Sub-Petition Map Set December 19, 2018 (revised March 21, 2019)








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




