NOTICE - CORRECTED

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50j-40(a) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies of a Petition to be filed with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Siting Council") on or after October 10, 2017 by MCM Communications, LLC ("MCM" or the "Petitioner"). MCM will seek a declaratory ruling that a temporary tower (the "Temporary Facility") proposed on property located at 1542 ~~River Road~~ **Boston Post Road** in the Town of Westbrook, Connecticut ("Site") does not have permanent or significant adverse environmental effect.

The Old Saybrook Police Department, AT&T, Verizon, and T-Mobile maintain wireless communications facilities on an existing water tank at the Site. That water tank will be demolished. The wireless communications facilities must be removed from the water tank and relocated to a temporary tower for continuity of service in the community while a permanent relocation site is secured as part of the local and state siting process.

The Temporary Facility consists of an approximately 163' above grade level ("AGL") ballast tower with Verizon antennas at a centerline height of 157' AGL, AT&T antennas at 147' AGL and T-Mobile antennas at 137' AGL. The Old Saybrook Police Department will install a whip antenna on the top of the temporary tower reaching to 171' AGL. The tower will be enclosed in a 26' x 27' compound surrounded by a 6' chain link fence. Existing ground equipment will remain for the operation of the Temporary Facility. The tower, fence and other equipment would be removed once a permanent facility is operational.

The Petition will provide details of the Temporary Facility and explain why MCM submits that the proposed temporary tower presents no permanent or significant adverse environmental effects. The location, height and other features of the facility are subject to review and potential change under provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes Sections 16-50g et. seq.




