### Interrogatories

June 23, 2017

1. Describe how the new telecommunications pole will be installed.
2. Is grading necessary for the installation?
3. Would the guardrail fronting New Rock Hill Road be removed for construction and/or to provide permanent site access?
4. If a section of the guardrail is to be temporarily or permanently removed, is approval required from the CT Department of Transportation and/or the Town?
5. Would a section of the fence depicted on Sheet C-2 be removed for the installation? If so, would a gate or replacement section be installed after facility installation is complete?
6. Would installation of the telecommunications pole affect the drainage culvert identified on Site Plan Sheet C-2?
7. Clarify the distance from the wood pole to the mapped wetland area (both 30 and 50 feet are listed).
8. Is the pole installation within a DEEP Natural Diversity Database marked area?
9. How many hours can the pole-mounted battery provide emergency power to the facility?
10. Did Cellco consider using the existing utility pole on the north side of New Rock Hill Road to support the antenna installation?
