RE: **PETITION NO. 1310** - Quinebaug Solar, LLC petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed construction, maintenance and operation of a 50 megawatt AC solar photovoltaic electric generating facility on approximately 561 acres comprised of 29 separate and abutting privately-owned parcels located generally north of Wauregan Road in Canterbury, Connecticut and south of Rukstela Road and Allen Hill Road in Brooklyn, Connecticut.

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On November 12, 2019, pursuant to the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §4-181a(b), Quinebaug Solar, LLC filed a Motion to Reopen the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council) December 7, 2017 decision to deny without prejudice a declaratory ruling to Quinebaug Solar, LLC for the above-referenced proposed solar photovoltaic electric generating facility in the Towns of Brooklyn and Canterbury.

The Motion to Reopen the Council's December 7, 2017 decision will be placed on the Council meeting agenda scheduled for December 5, 2019 for Council consideration.

Parties and intervenors are requested to submit comments or statements of position in writing to the Council with respect to whether the Motion to Reopen should be granted or denied and **whether a public hearing should be held on this request** before the close of business on November 27, 2019.
