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Q. Please provide an update on the stormwater design and permitting status.

Ameresco and Amec Foster Wheeler met with CT DEEP on October 5, 2017 to discuss the status and approval requirements for the Project's stormwater management and erosion and sediment control plans. CT DEEP discussed the requirements that need to be met in order for the Project construction to be eligible for coverage under the General Permit for the Discharge of Stormwater and Dewatering Wastewaters from Construction Activities (Construction General Permit). Since the array layout and associated disturbed area has been reduced to decrease the potential impact on habitat areas, the site and stormwater designs will be modified. Modifications to the site and stormwater designs will be done in accordance with the Construction General Permit requirements, and the 2002 Connecticut Guidelines for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control. A Registration Form for coverage under the Construction General Permit, including supporting information and a Stormwater Pollution Control Plan will be submitted for CT DEEP approval following completion of NDDDB review by CT DEEP, which is required before filing for coverage under the Construction General Permit.
