Accordingly, DWW revises its March 12, 2019 response to the Council’s Interrogatory Number 6 and states as follows:


Q6. Has the General Permit for the Discharge of Stormwater and Dewatering Wastewaters from Construction Activities been filed with DEEP? What is its current status?

A6. **The General Permit for the Discharge of Stormwater and Dewatering Wastewaters from Construction Activities was filed with DEEP on January 15, 2019, and received by the DEEP on January 17, 2019. The Project has had discussions with staff from the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection regarding DWW’s filing. DEEP informed DWW that DWW is compliant with the requirements of the General Permit and assigned Permit No. GSN003423 to the Project. A copy of that letter is attached.**
