MOTION TO DENY DECLARATORY RULING

Pursuant to § 16-50j-22a(b) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, the Town of Simsbury ("Town"), through counsel, respectfully moves the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") to deny Petition No. 1313 ("Petition"), initiated by DWW Solar II, LLC ("DWW"). On or about August 23, 2017, the Connecticut Department of Agriculture ("DOA") filed a Motion to Deny Declaratory Ruling on the ground that the Petition does not meet the procedural requirements of General Statutes § 16-50(a), as amended by Public Act 17-218. Accordingly, DWW must file and obtain a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need ("Certificate") pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50g *et seq.* The Town hereby agrees with and adopts the DOA's motion and supporting memorandum.

The Town strongly believes that the proposed project must be vetted thoroughly and in accordance with the Certificate requirements. Public Act 17-218 was passed with the unified and overwhelming support of State legislative, executive and administrative agencies, as well as the State's municipalities. The Act represents the Legislature's clear acknowledgment that supporting sustainable energy and preserving open space, forests and farms are worthy goals that can and should be pursued in a complimentary manner, but not at the expense of one policy over

the other. As set forth in the Town's Prehearing Submission, as well as the submissions of the other participants to this proceeding, many questions remain unanswered in connection with the Petition and, at the very least, the higher level of review accompanying a Certificate proceeding is warranted.

WHEREFORE, the Town respectfully moves the Council to deny the Petition.
