RE: **PETITION NO. 1314** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the proposed 1555 Line Rebuild Project consisting of the structure and conductor replacements on its existing 115-kilovolt electric transmission line extending approximately 6.6 miles within existing Eversource electric transmission line right-of-way between the existing Bulls Bridge Substation located at 781 Kent Road and the existing Rocky River Junction located off Boardman Road in New Milford, Connecticut.

Dear Ms. Taylor:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated April 9, 2019, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on August 31, 2017.

Pursuant to Condition No. 1 of the Council's Decision on August 31, 2017 and page 3 of the Council staff report, your request to perform work Monday through Saturday from 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. on April 15, 2019 through May 31, 2019 at the following locations in the vicinity of the #1555 Line are hereby approved:

- April 15th through April 19th – Bull's Bridge Substation to Structure No. 567;
- April 29th through May 3rd – Structure No. 567 to Structure No. 541;
- May 6th through May 10th – Structure No. 2626 to Structure No. 2606; and
- May 13th through May 17th – Structure No. 2606 to Rocky River Substation.

The extended work hours are necessary as a contingency due to unexpected outage recalls from CONVEX during the four conductor pulls on the #1555 Line.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated April 9, 2019. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.



The extended hours are a contingency due to unexpected outage recalls from CONVEX during the four conductor pulls on the 1555 Line at the following locations:

1. April 15 – April 19: Bull's Bridge Substation to Structure 567
2. April 29 – May 3 : Structure 567 to Structure 541
3. May 6 – May 10: Structure 2626 to Structure 2606
4. May 13 – May 17: Structure 2606 to Rocky River Substation

*Note: The schedule may change due to inclement weather delays.

The Town of New Milford has been notified and abutters will be notified in advance of the proposed work schedule.
