RE: **PETITION NO. 1337** - The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy petition for a declaratory ruling, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-176 and §16-50k, for the proposed Stepstone to Green Hill Substation Upgrade Project that includes replacement of approximately 5.6 miles of its existing No. 1508 115-kilovolt (kV) electric transmission line structures within existing Eversource electric transmission line right of way between Stepstone Substation located at 50 Stepstone Road, Guilford, Connecticut and Green Hill Substation located at 775 Green Hill Road, Madison, Connecticut, and related electric transmission line structure improvements.

Dear Ms. Taylor:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the email correspondence dated April 4, 2018, regarding temporary changes to work hours for the above-referenced project that was approved by the Council on February 1, 2018.

Pursuant to Condition No. 2 of the Council's Decision on February 1, 2018, your request to perform Sunday work hours on April 8, 15, 29, and May 6, 2018 is hereby approved. All Sunday work would be performed from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and would include structure installation, transferring the conductor and removing existing structures in Guilford and Madison during scheduled outages. The change in work hours is necessary to recover work time lost due to recent winter storm events.

This approval applies only to the request for changes to work hours dated April 4, 2018. Any significant changes to the project require advance Council notification and approval.


